STANFORD TAKES THE TITLE AT IRVINE

No. 1 UCLA defeated HAWAII 16-7 in a MPSF match then notched wins over Santa Clara, UC IRVINE and CALIFORNIA before STANFORD handed the Bruins a 4-8 loss, their first of the season in the Championship game at UCI.....No. 2 Stanford won the UCI Tournament beating Michigan, SAN JOSE STATE and USC before the finale where they defeated UCLA 8-4. **Lauren Silver** scored three goals vs. UCLA and tossed in nine in four games for the tournament.....No.3. USC defeated LONG BEACH STATE and UC Davis before falling to Stanford 8-10 placing them in the 3rd place game at UCI where they defeated California 15-9. **Erika Figge** scored 6 goals for the Trojans for the weekendNo. 4 HAWAII came to the mainland after winning three at home last weekend. They lost to UCLA and defeated UC Irvine in MPSF games before winning one over UC SANTA BARBARA then losing three in a row to California, UC Irvine and UC Davis.....No. 5 California split the weekend with wins over UC San Diego and HAWAII and losses to UCLA and USC at UCI.No. 6 San Jose State defeated ARIZONA STATE, lost to Stanford, defeated UC Davis then lost to Hawaii to finish 2-2 at UCI.....No. 8 SAN DIEGO STATE led by **Anna Gonzales** with 10 goals for the weekend, lost to UCI then won three in a row defeating Santa Clara, UC Santa Barbara and Loyola Marymount 8-6 in O.T.No. 9 UC IRVINE lost a MPSF game to Hawaii before taking home team advantage and going 3-1 at their invitational defeating San Diego State, losing to UCLA and defeating Hawaii and San Jose State. Goalie **Lauren Machanis** averaged 11.6 saves for 5 games saving 16 in the win over HawaiiNo. 11 Arizona State was downed by San Jose State, defeated Michigan lost to Loyola Marymount 8-9 and won a O.T. decision 13-11 to close out the weekendNo. 12 UC Santa Barbara defeated UC San Diego and lost to Hawaii, San Diego State and Arizona State for a 6-6 season record overallNo. 15 Long Beach State lost to USC and Loyola Marymount on Saturday, defeated Michigan on Sunday and fell to Santa Clara in O.T. 10-11CS Northridge got two wins at the Redlands Mini Tournament defeating CS San Bernardino 13-4 and Cal Baptist 6-4..... Pacific notched their first two wins of the season at the Sonoma State Tournament defeating La Verne and UC Santa Cruz. The Tigers lost to host Sonoma State and CS Monterey Bay.....
