BYU, UC Irvine win to set up two-match showdown this week

Hawai'i swept two matches from USC to extend the Warriors' winning streak to seven matches. OH **Jose Delgado** had 20 kills (.400) in the first match and OH **Matt Carere** added 18 kills (.452) and eight digs for Hawai'i. In the second meeting, OH **Lauri Hakala** had 16 kills (.407) and seven blocks and Carere added 11 kills (.391). OH **Juan Figueroa** had 20 kills (.205) in the first match for USC and 16 (.103) in the second. Hawai'i out-blocked USC 14.5-5.5 in Match 2. ... BYU swept two matches from visiting Stanford behind OH **Yosleyder Cala**, who had 25 kills (.697) combined. MB **Russell Holmes** added 23 kills (.700). ... OH **Ben Reddy** had a team-high 25 kills (.109) in two matches against BYU. OH **Jesse Meredith** had 12 kills (.733) in the second match against the Cougars. ... CS Northridge rebounded from two losses to Hawai'i to beat No. 5 Long Beach St. and UC San Diego last week. Freshman OH **Eric Vance** had 23 kills (.341) against the 49ers and 19 (.464) vs. the Tritons. MB **Brian Waite** had 11 kills (.381), three aces and eight blocks against LBSU and 10 kills (.538) and six blocks against UCSD. ... MB **Duncan Budinger** had 28 kills (.457) for Long Beach St. against CSUN and OH **Robert Tarr** added 20 (.375). The 49ers rallied from a 2-0 deficit to defeat host UC Santa Barbara. OH **Paul Lotman** had a career high 18 kills (.615). Tarr also had 18 kills (.368). ... OP **Evan Patak** had 24 kills (.220) and five aces against LBSU for UCSB, which five players in double-figure kills. The 49ers out-blocked the Gauchos 20-5.5. Patak also had six aces and 19 kills (.654) against UC San Diego. MB **Derek Otte** added 13 kills (.550) for UCSB. ... OHs **Mike Reuter** (.375) and **Jon Daze** (.333) had 11 kills apiece for UC San Diego against UCSB. Daze had a team-high eight kills (.043), an ace and five blocks in a loss to CSUN. ... UCLA lost matches to No. 2 UC Irvine and No. 3 Pepperdine at home. OP **Steve Klosterman** had 27 kills (.511) against Pepperdine and 18 (.262) vs. UC Irvine. ... Pepperdine freshman OH **Paul Carroll** had 16 kills (.324) and MB **John Parfitt** added 15 (.265) against the Bruins. ... Despite an off-night for OHs **Matt Weber** (.189/17 kills) and **Jayson Jablonsky** (.184/13 kills), UC Irvine swept UCLA. MB **Aaron Harrell** had 12 kills (.611) and five blocks for the Anteaters.
