MPSF TOURNAMENT RECAP

STANFORD WINS MPSF CHAMPIONSHIP

#2 seed STANFORD beat 1 DENVER in a decisive 12-6 victory this afternoon at Oregon's Papé Field. The Cardinal overcame a 4-3 Denver lead with less than 10 minutes remaining in the first-half to take a 6-4 lead into the intermission. The Cardinal held the Pioneers to two goals in the second-half in a strong defensive display. Senior attackers **Megan Burkner** and **Sarah Bach** spearheaded Stanford's offense with four goals apiece, with MPSF Championship Tournament MVP Burkner adding a pair of assists.

In Sunday's third-place game the #4 seeded Oregon Ducks outlasted #3 seed California 9-8 in a stirring come from behind defensive battle that allowed the host Ducks to finish with a 10-9 winning record in the program's second year. Cal drops to 8-11 on the season to finish in fourth-place. Sophomore midfielder **Jen May** paced the Oregon offense with four goals as keeper **Anna Poponyak** recorded an even dozen saves in goal. Senior attacker **Laura Cavallo** posted a hat trick for the Bears with goalie **Hilary Lynch** notching 11 saves.
