No. 1 USC scored 14 to HAWAII's 7 and remains undefeated with one game left in the regular season. **Anna Pardo** and **Kami Craig** led the Women of Troy with three goals each .....No. 2 STANFORD fell to UCLA 8-9 in an overtime thriller. **Alison Gregorka**, **Katie Hansen** and **Christina Hewko** each scored two but it was not enough to overtake the Bruins.....No. 3 UCLA breezed by Pacific 19-1 but had a battle on their hands against Stanford winning 9-8 in OT. **Jillian Kraus** sent the game in to overtime at 7-7 with 12.6 seconds to go and **Brittany Rowe** and **Anne Belden** threw in one each in OT for the win.....No. 5 HAWAII finished their regular season in style defeating No. 4 Loyola Marymount 6-5, putting in a good effort but losing to USC 7-14 and going on to defeat LONG BEACH STATE 10-7 and Cal State Northridge 10-4. **Kelly Mason** led the Wahine with three goals against the Beach.....No. 6 CALIFORNIA defeated SAN JOSE STATE 5-2 marking the Bears 9<sup>th</sup> victory in their last 10 matches. **Heather Stuart** had nine saves in goal while five different players contributed to the scoring.....No. 8 San Diego State San Diego State defeated UC SANTA BARBARA 11-7 to celebrate their Senior Day. **Elana Cervantes**, **Savanah Kelley** and **Rachel Serna** led the Aztecs with 2 goals each.....No. 9 San Jose State came out on the short end in a 2-5 loss to No. Cal rival California.....No. 10 Long Beach State swept the first day of the Beach Tournament, defeating CS Northridge 11-15 and CS Bakersfield by identical 8-4 scores.
