### LAST SHOT FOR CHAMPIONSHIP SEEDING

No. 1 USC kept their winning streak alive as they defeated UC SANTA BARBARA 16-9. Freshman **Kami Craig** led the Women of Troy with four goals to close out the regular season .....No. 2 UCLA defeated LONG BEACH STATE 11-4 to finish with an 11-1 conference record. Senior **Kristina Kunkel** scored three goals to lead the Bruins .....No. 3 STANFORD defeated SAN JOSE STATE 9-3 to finish the season in third place with a 10-2 conference record.....No. 6 CALIFORNIA traveled to PACIFIC and took home a 15-3 win to close out the regular season.....No. 7 UC IRVINE almost got by #5 ranked Loyola Marymount playing four overtime periods before taking a 8-9 loss. The next day they showed their fitness and ability to come back by defeating CAL STATE NORTHRIDGE 12-8 to close out the season.....No. 8 SAN DIEGO STATE defeated UC San Diego 6-5 to win the Harper Cup. The Aztecs luck did not hold out as they suffered a 4-5 loss to ARIZONA STATE the following day.....No. 9 San Jose State lost to Stanford 3-9 to close out the conference season. That afternoon they took out their frustration on the Banana Slugs from UC Santa Cruz posting a 15-1 win to finish on a high note.....No. 10 Long Beach State ended up on the short end of a 4-11 UCLA victory to close out the regular season with a 4-8 conference record.....No. 11 Arizona State scored an upset victory over San Diego State 5-4 to go in to the tournament with a one game winning streak .....No. 13 UC Santa Barbara posted a 9-16 loss to undefeated USC. The following day they warmed up for the tournament with wins over Pomona 13-2, Chapman 16-4 and Cal State San Bernardino 15-5 to take a three game streak in to the tournament.....No. 19 Cal State Northridge lost to UC Irvine 8-12 in their final game of the regular season.....PACIFIC posted two losses to UC Davis and California to end a challenging season. Senior **Julia Snyder** led the Tigers with two goals against the Bears as five seniors played their last regular season contest.....No. 4 HAWAII stayed home to tune up for the MPSF Tournament.....
