NEW MEXICO WINS FOURTH STRAIGHT MPSF TITLE, HEADS TO NCAA

NEW MEXICO earned two shutouts this past weekend, a 2-0 win at Air Force and a 0-0 tie at Denver, resulting in a fourth consecutive MPSF Championship and sixth in the last seven years. The Lobos head to Los Angeles to face UCLA in the first round of the NCAA Tournament Saturday (Nov. 24) at 7:00 p.m. (PST). No. 7 national seed Santa Clara hosts the winner in second round action Wednesday (Nov. 28). Last Friday against the Falcons, UNM scored twice in the 88th-minute as sophomores **Justin Davis** and **PJ Wilson** lifted the 21st-ranked Lobos 24 seconds apart. Senior **Mike Graczyk** picked up five saves against the Pioneers and earned his fifth and sixth shutouts of the year....

DENVER earned a 1-0 shutout at home over UNLV Friday, as junior defender **Colin Jones** struck in the 81st-minute. The Pioneers proceeded to end the season in second place with a 0-0 tie with New Mexico, their second draw with the Lobos this year. Senior **Matt Bredehoff** finished with five shutouts this year, notching nine saves in all 200 minutes in the final weekend, seven vs. UNM. Denver concludes 2007 10-4-4 overall, 6-1-3 in the MPSF, and unbeaten in its last eight games. Junior **Kyle Christensen** was second in the MPSF in goals scored with nine, and fourth on the overall scoring list with 18 points....

SAN JOSE STATE slipped by Sacramento State in the season finale 1-0, as senior **Julio Gonzalez** found sophomore **Nick Cukar** just before halftime. Junior **Lewis Sweeney** collected four saves putting his total to 50 on the season. The five saves per game average is expected to be amongst the national leaders in the final NCAA statistics. Senior **Ismael Ibarra** ranked second in the MPSF with 1.11 points per game and second with nine goals. The Spartans turned in a 10-9 season, 5-5 in conference action, taking third place with 15 points....

SACRAMENTO STATE was edged 1-0 at home Sunday by San Jose State to end the season. The Hornets finish fourth in the MPSF with 10 points at 3-6-1, with an overall record of 4-13-2. Freshman **Ernesto Carranza** contributed a team-high nine points on three goals and three assists. Junior **Blake Nunes** tallied a team-high four goals with eight points, and was named the October 22 Conference Player of the Week....

UNLV fell 1-0 at Denver Friday and at Air Force Sunday, as freshman goalkeeper **Roland Swanson** registered eight saves vs. the Pioneers. The Rebels finish 2007 with a 7-10-2 overall mark, 3-7 in MPSF play, recording their most overall wins in a season since 2002. Junior **Lamar Neagle** led the scoring with nine goals and 1.05 points per game....

AIR FORCE dropped a 2-0 decision at home to No. 21 New Mexico Friday, though bounced back to edge UNLV on a productive Senior Day, 1-0. **Andy Nigro** scored in his final collegiate game, while **Brian Guyette** picked up eight saves against both the Lobos and Rebels. He finishes the year with 107 stops, a statistic that currently ranks in the top-10 nationally. Nigro, along with senior **Ian Hauck**, each recorded three goals on the year....

BREDEHOFT AND GRACZYK NAMED MPSF BRINE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Woodland, CA--**Denver** senior goalkeeper **Matt Bredehoff** (Fort Collins, CO / Poudre HS) posted two shutouts in his final weekend of collegiate competition, as the Pioneers edged UNLV 1-0 and tied 21st-ranked New Mexico 0-0 in a double-overtime battle. Bredehoff totaled nine saves in 200 minutes on the weekend, seven vs. the Lobos. Four of the seven saves in his final game came in the second half.... **New Mexico** senior goalkeeper **Mike Graczyk** (Albuquerque, NM / La Cueva HS) also earned a pair of shutouts in 200 minutes, in the Lobos' 2-0 win at Air Force and 0-0 tie at Denver. He totaled six saves for the weekend, five vs. the Pioneers which helped lead to a fourth straight MPSF Championship. Graczyk also won this award on Sept. 24....

2007 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2007 NCAA College Cup semifinals and championship matches are hosted by North Carolina State University, and will take place Friday, December 14 & Sunday, December 16 at SAS Stadium in Cary, North Carolina. First-round NCAA Tournament play begins on Friday, November 23 and Saturday, November 24.
