### **2007 MPSF Player of the Year**

UC Irvine senior two-meter man Tim Hutten (Seal Beach, CA/Los Alamitos HS) led the Anteaters with 75 goals this season and tops the MPSF with an average of 3.75 goals per game after a redshirt year in 2006. He scored at least four goals in 10 of UCI's 25 games, including a school-record nine in an 18-6, non-conference win over UC San Diego Nov. 7. Hutten was named MVP of the MPSF Tournament after scoring 12 goals in three games as the fifth-seeded Anteaters advanced to the championship game for the first time in history. He had three goals in a 10-9, sudden-victory overtime win over UCLA, five in a 13-12 win over top-seeded Cal, and four in the 10-6 loss to top-ranked USC in the final. Hutten played for the U.S. National Team this past summer and was a redshirt at UCI last season. As a junior in 2005, he scored 64 goals for the Anteaters and was named second-team All-America.

After joining UC Santa Barbara nine games into the season, Golic made an immediate impact on the Gaucho offense, finishing second on the team with 53 goals scored and first with a goals per game average of 2.3, good for sixth in conference. He posted 17 multiple-goal games including seven games with a hat trick or more. Golic led UCSB with nine goals in last weekend's MPSF Tournament including five against UCLA in the fifth-place game. In addition to his prolific scoring, Golic led the team in assists during the season. Played for Partizan Belgrade with which he has won more than 20 national championships and cups and earned several tournament MVP honors. Golic, born on June 22, 1988, played in the European Championship with the Serbian National Youth Team which he names as his most memorable athletic achievement. Golic is majoring in business and managerial economics.
