CAL STAYS PERFECT IN MPSF, HOSTS SECOND PLACE USC SATURDAY

CALIFORNIA was once again led on offense by senior **Michael Sharf** this past weekend, scoring a match-high five goals in an 11-10 overtime win vs. UCI and three more in a 10-8 win at UCSB. Against the No. 5 Anteaters, the top-ranked Bears had to comeback the entire match, which included a 5-1 second quarter deficit. Senior **Mike Hayes** ultimately sent the game to overtime with two seconds left, setting up a game-winner with 1:15 left in the second OT by senior **Adam Haley**. Cal hosts USC in an MPSF showdown Saturday (Nov. 10), trying to avenge one of its two losses this season. USC was idle this past week. After facing the top-ranked Bears Saturday, the Trojans visit Pacific Sunday (Nov. 11)....

LONG BEACH STATE upset No. 5 Pepperdine in Malibu Saturday, 7-5. Down 1-0 early, the 49ers answered with three straight goals and never trailed again. Senior **Clint Wilson** tallied a team-high three goals while senior **Steve MacKenzie** stopped 10 shots in the cage. The 49ers also allowed the first goal Sunday to Pomona, only to score the next 11 in an 11-1 win. LMU and UCSB visit on Thursday (Nov. 8) and Sunday (Nov. 11).

UCLA had no trouble in its lone game this past week, a 14-6 win at No. 14 UC San Diego. The Tritons scored first, but the Bruins came back to lead 4-1 after one period and coasted throughout. Sophomore **Scott Swanson** nailed a hat trick. UCLA returns to MPSF action when UC Santa Barbara visits on Saturday (Nov. 10) at 1 pm, in the first meeting of the season between the two teams....

STANFORD posted three wins this past week over UC Santa Cruz (22-7), No. 8 UC Davis (6-4), and No. 13 Pacific (14-7). The Cardinal raced out to a 9-2 lead by the half in the conference game in Stockton, as senior **Michael Bury** and freshman **Alex Pulido** each tallied a hat trick. Senior **Sandy Hohener** stopped 11 shots. Stanford heads to UC Irvine for an important MPSF battle Saturday (Nov. 10)....

UC IRVINE split a pair of road games, an 11-10 overtime loss at No. 1 Cal and a 13-7 win at Pacific. Senior **Tim Hutten** totaled eight goals on the trip. The Anteaters host UC San Diego in a make-up game Wednesday (Nov. 7), followed by MPSF action with Pepperdine and Stanford Nov. 9-10....

PEPPERDINE fell 7-5 to No. 8 Long Beach State in Malibu Saturday. Junior **Adam Hewko** tallied a hat trick. In game two, the No. 5 Waves got past No. 20 Cal Baptist 13-9 as sophomores **Clayton Snyder** and **JP MacDonnell** each scored four goals. Next up is a visit to UC Irvine Friday (Nov. 9).

UC SANTA BARBARA came up just short of top-ranked California, 10-8 at home Sunday. Sophomore **Zsombor Vincze** turned in a Gaucho-best three goals for his third straight hat trick. UCSB heads south to face UCLA and Long Beach State Saturday and Sunday (Nov. 10 & 11)....

PACIFIC dropped a pair of MPSF weekend home games, 13-7 to No. 5 UC Irvine and 14-7 to No. 4 Stanford. Senior **Brian Domecus** registered 13 saves in goal vs. the Cardinal. Junior **Duje Kaurlo** combined for six goals in two games. The Tigers visit UC Davis and host USC, Nov. 10 & 11....

WARDEN AND HUTTEN NAMED MPSF MIKASA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Woodland, Calif. – **California** sophomore **Spencer Warden** (Soquel, CA) played a large role in two MPSF wins this past weekend. He totaled six assists vs. No. 5 UC Irvine and No. 7 UC Santa Barbara and tallied a team-high three goals in the 10-8 win over the Gauchos....

UC Irvine senior **Tim Hutten** (Seal Beach, CA) scored eight goals in two MPSF road games. He helped the Anteaters take No.1 Cal into overtime with three goals, the last of which tied the game late in the fourth quarter. He then added a game-high five goals in a 13-7 win at Pacific. Hutten is currently the leading scorer in the conference with 3.62 goals per game....
