MPSF HEADS TO IRVINE FOR ANNUAL SOCAL TOURNAMENT

USC won its eighth straight with a 7-2 MPSF win over No. 3 Stanford in Los Angeles Saturday. Ahead 4-2 with about four minutes left in the first half, the Trojans blanked the Cardinal in the final 2 ½ periods. Senior **Tommy Corcoran** and sophomore **Jordan Thompson** each scored twice. Junior **Adam Shilling** collected 10 saves. Top-ranked USC plays Redlands at 8 am Saturday (Oct. 13) to open the annual SoCal Tournament....

CALIFORNIA moved to 13-1 on the season with wins over Harvard (16-4), No. 16 Air Force (11-2), and at No. 9 UC Davis (17-12). Senior **Michael Sharf** poured in six goals on the Aggies, while senior **Vladislav Andreyev** added four vs. the Falcons and had a game-high five vs. the Crimson. The Bears open up the 2007 SoCal Tournament by taking on Pomona-Pitzer Saturday at 8 am, also facing Long Beach State or St. Francis later that day. UCLA exploded for seven goals in the second quarter Friday in Irvine, the difference in a 12-5 MPSF outcome over No. 6 UCI. The Bruins were behind 3-1 after one, but took charge from then on, beginning with six unanswered goals in the second. Senior **Justin Johnson** scored a hat trick, while sophomore **Chay Lapin** picked up 13 saves. UCLA also had no problem with No. 20 Brown Saturday, 16-4, as 11 Bruins scored at least once. Pacific is the first opponent at the SoCal Tournament Saturday at 10:40 am, followed by a second game with Pepperdine or Bucknell....

PEPPERDINE routed the Claremont Convergence field with five easy wins over Occidental (17-5), Chapman (17-2), Pomona-Pitzer (17-1) on Saturday, and Brown (17-4) and Redlands (12-5) on Friday. Sophomore **Clayton Snyder** scored six goals on day one, while freshman **Uriel Villa** posted eight goals on day two. The Waves meet Bucknell Saturday at noon in their first SoCal Tourney game, and will face UCLA or Pacific next....

LONG BEACH STATE won four games this past week, 11-8 (OT) at No. 10 LMU, 12-10 at No. 12 UC San Diego, 10-4 over No. 20 Brown, and 9-5 over MIT. Sophomore **Jeff Greenwood** had eight goals in four games. Junior **Pavle Filipovic** and senior **Reid Tomassi** each had four-goal outings, at UCSD and LMU respectively. The 49ers begin the SoCal with St. Francis Saturday at 9:20 am, and could face No. 2 Cal in the afternoon....

UC SANTA BARBARA outlasted No. 12 UC San Diego 13-10 Friday night in La Jolla, in a game that featured six ties. Up 10-9 after three quarters, the Gauchos put the game away by scoring the last two goals and keeping the Tritons scoreless in the final seven minutes. Sophomore **Zsombor Vincze** and freshman **Milos Golic** each posted a hat trick. UCSB tries to take down Loyola Marymount for the third time, 9:20 am Saturday in Irvine.

PACIFIC had a seven-goal effort from junior **Duje Kuarloto** in a 15-12 win over Cal Baptist at the Pacific Invite. The Tigers also knocked off Fresno Pacific 21-9, Harvard 18-6, and George Washington 18-11. Pacific faces UCLA in its first SoCal game, with Pepperdine or Bucknell up next....

STANFORD fell 7-2 to No. 1 USC Saturday on the Trojan campus. Senior **Sandy Hohener** had 11 saves in the cage. Princeton is the first SoCal Tournament opponent for the No. 3 Cardinal at 10:40 am Saturday, followed by a meeting with either UC Irvine or UC San Diego later that day....

UC IRVINE dropped a 12-5 MPSF contest to No. 4 UCLA Friday night at Anteater Pool. Senior **Collin Mello** tallied three goals. UCI is the host of this year's SoCal Tournament, as the Anteaters will first take on UC San Diego Saturday at noon, and then Stanford or Princeton in the late afternoon....

SHILLING AND ANDREYEV EARN MPSF MIKASA PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Woodland, Calif. – USC junior goalkeeper **Adam Shilling** (Fremont, CA/ Bellarmine Prep) allowed only two goals, including a shutout for the final 2 ½ periods, in a 7-2 win over No. 3 Stanford this past Saturday in Los Angeles. Both Cardinal goals came on a 6-on-5 situation. Shilling also recorded 10 saves and two steals. He owns an MPSF-best 4.50 goals-against average....California senior **Vladislav Andreyev** (Kazakhstan/ Diablo Valley College) doubled his season scoring total with 12 goals in three games over the weekend. He poured in three hat tricks, five goals vs. Harvard, four vs. No. 16 Air Force, and three at No. 9 UC Davis. Andreyev, who was previously not amongst the conference scoring leaders, jumped to No. 15 with 1.71 goals per game....
