Part Three: BYLAWS-SPORTS ADMINISTRATION

300 RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

300.1 **Basic Standards**

300.1.1 Eligibility and participation rules for the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation shall be the eligibility rules of the institution and the primary Conference of which the institution is a member.

300.1.2 Eligibility and participation rules for Mountain Pacific student-athletes whose institution does not have a primary Conference shall be the eligibility rules of the institution and the NCAA.

300.2 **Transfer Rule**

300.2.1 If a Mountain Pacific student-athlete transfers within his/her primary Conference (e.g. from Pac-10 to Pac-10 institution), that Conference's intraconference transfer rule shall apply.

300.2.2 If a Mountain Pacific student-athlete transfers to institution outside his/her primary Conference (e.g. from Big West to Pac-10 institution), the NCAA's four-year college transfer rule shall apply.

300.3 **Reporting**

300.3.1 The filing of eligibility forms for Mountain Pacific Sports Federation sports shall be with the institution's primary Conference office under the specifications of the respective Conference's rules and regulations.

300.3.2 The Faculty Athletics Representative of the member institutions shall be responsible for administering these rules; there shall be a free flow of information among the members on all matters of Federation concern.

301 AID TO ATHLETES

301.1 Permissible Aid.

In order to make it possible for student-athletes to have adequate time to pursue their studies, participate in athletics, and enjoy a cross-section of student activities, member schools are permitted to give scholarships, grants-in-aid, and/or part-time employment as defined in NCAA Bylaws, Article 15 (Principles Governing Financial Aid).

302 **RECRUITING**

302.1 NCAA Regulations.
